English

Science

The focus this half term is sound. The children will learn what sound is and how it is made. They will look at how it travels over distance, how sounds are measured and parts of the ear. They will also learn about pitch and volume, which will tie in nicely with their music lessons!

Topic

The focus this half term is 'Anglo-Saxons. The key question and focus for this will be: 'Who were the Anglo Saxons and how do we know what was important to them?' We will be taking a trip to West Stow Anglo-Saxon village to immerse the children in Anglo-Saxon life and broaden their knowledge and understanding of the past.
