Curriculum Newsletter Autumn 2023

Mathematics

The focus this term is...

Place Value - We will be focussing on recognising the value of numerals in a two-digit number, representing numbers in different ways, estimating on a number line, comparing objects and numbers and counting in 2's, 5's, 10's and 3's.

Addition and Subtraction-We will begin revisiting number bonds to 10 and fact families followed by adding and subtracting by making 10. After this we will work on adding and subtracting two 2-digit numbers and compare number sentences. Shape-To finish the term we will explore 2D shapes, counting the sides and vertices and 3D shapes, counting the faces and edges. We will also explore lines of symmetry.

Help from Home

Please read with your child daily (little and often works best!) and record any reading that you do together in their reading diaries.

Please also practise spellings (spelling shed) and complete the weekly homework on Google
Classroom.

Science

The focus this term is...

Animals including Humans.

We will be learning about different types of animals and their young, focussing on how they change as they grow up.

We will also discover what animals need for survival. Importantly we will investigate what being healthy means and why it is important to exercise and maintain a healthy diet for humans.

The writing focus this term is:
