Road Safety

We continue to receive reports from concerned parents around the pupils' use of the roads and pavements around school both before the school day and after. Concerns being raised are:

- Children riding their bikes and scooters off the pavement and straight into the road without pause and looking for dangers;
- Children riding their bikes and scooters straight across the zebra crossings near school without stopping to check that drivers have seen them and slowed down for them to cross;
- Children riding up and down the footpaths at speed and carelessly on their bikes and scooters where other members of the school community with younger pupils are also trying to walk to school.

We will of course speak to the children again in school about these behaviours and once again advise them on how to be safe. We would appreciate parents/carers also reinforcing these messages at home.

Stranger Danger

Following an incident which took place on the Cedars Park estate over the half term, where pupils at the school were approached by adults in a car, we have two local police officers visiting the school on Monday. They will talk to the Key Stage Two children in assembly about how to keep themselves safe when going to and from school, as well as when they are in the local community.

In addition, the Early Years and Key Stage One children will have an age-appropriate 'stranger danger' assembly led by Mrs Green on Monday too.

On this occasion, the children involved behaved admirably—they did exactly the right thing and kept themselves safe.

We ask parents/carers to follow up on how to keep safe in the community, and talk to their children about stranger danger, at home to reinforce these key messages.
