We have had several incidents of children falling and injuring themselves in the playground before the start of the school day. Please can we remind parents that the children should not be playing before school at this very busy time.



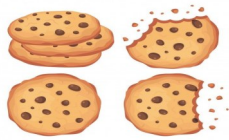
## Children In Need
